TREASURER'S REPORT

Zoe presented the financial report from January 1 to April 3, 2011.

Total expenses	\$36,005.51
Total deposits	\$52,021.38
Open invoices due (from registration)	\$18,217.00

There is an additional \$31,000 held in a separate savings account. The club bond funds are also being moved to a separate savings account.

Clubs with outstanding invoices are asked to pay those as soon as possible.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

EXECUTIVE VP'S REPORT

Clubs are asked to review code of conduct in the coaches' manual and attempt to ensure compliance of coaches, parents and players.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Tom will send out his seasonal memo to coaches. He stresses

1. Report scores promptly to commissioners.
2. Uniform includes jersey, shorts and socks. Please have unity of uniform for teams.
3. Commissioners for each division will be posted on website and will contact coaches shortly.

Playoffs will be held June 10-12. Occasionally a Sunday division will be moved to a Saturday for playoffs, with appropriate notice given.

Just a reminder that the referee fees posted are half the total – each team pays that amount. For example, if fee listed is \$15, the total referee fee is \$30.

Reschedules for weather should be handled promptly. Late in the season, we tend to run out of daylight.

Coaching clinics have been filled. There are a few more coming (see OYSAN.org for schedule). Please remind coaches to get their U10/12 license as required.

Scholarship application deadline is April 15. Players must be a high school senior graduating this year.

Tom handed out a flyer for the city of Akron's inaugural tournament for C3, C4, C5 teams only. They will not accept C1, C2 teams. This is a great opportunity for some of these lower division teams to play in a tournament. Tournament is scheduled for June 18-19, 2011.

Changes to the website for the fall season include an all club game schedule – you will be able to input a club code and pull up all of the games (and only the games) for your club.
